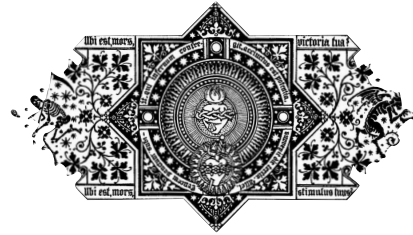

8. Repeat steps 5-7 for the next four decades.
9. Say the Concluding Prayers.

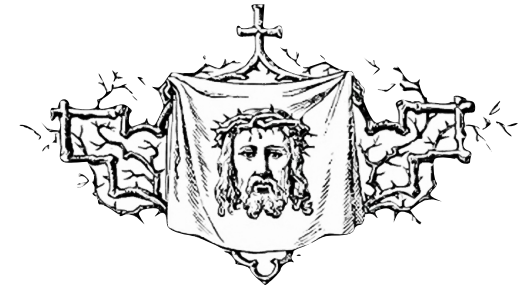
